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Dear Parent or Carer,

Summer Term Home Learning

We hope that you and all of your family are well.

At present there is no indication as to when schools will be re-opening and so for the time being we will continue to provide you with learning opportunities for the children to do at home.

Those children of key workers who are in school will be having a maths and English lesson every morning. We will be using the online resources provided by White Rose and Hamilton Trust respectively. These provide a week's worth of lessons and are tailored each year group's curriculum. We have put these resources on the website should you choose to mirror what is being done in school.

The feedback we have had from some parents is that they don't know how maths is taught in class, so we have chosen White Rose because each online lesson is accompanied by a video explaining to the children the methodology and the tasks.

The website also provides downloadable sheets, however in most instances there isn't the necessity to print these off in order to do the tasks. If the children use the exercise book we provided, write the date and title on a page as they would do in class, they can answer the questions in that way.

The class teachers are also going to assign tasks on the Education City website that will cover that week's maths focus.

The Hamilton Trust English tasks are accompanied by teaching notes. Again, there is the choice of using the downloadable worksheets or answering the questions directly into the exercise book.



For those children with SEN, Mrs Maguire is going to continue to set tasks on Education City. The children may also want to have a go at some of the activities detailed above, however it may be worth looking at the tasks provided for a younger age group.

The Oxford Owls online reading books are still accessible via the link on the school website. We have also put links to other sites that also provide e-books to read or listen to.

Finally, the teachers in Years 1 to 6 have put on their class page of the website this half term's weekly spellings and topic enrichment suggestions linked to what the class would have been studying if we were in school. Mrs Hesketh is planning to be providing some online phonics teaching for the children in Reception.

We hope that all of the above will provide sufficient and varied home learning opportunities. If you have any concerns or questions for your child's class teacher, please continue to send these to school via email. They will be forwarded on and the appropriate member of staff will get back to you.
